Trinity Sixth Form Dress Code



Trinity Sixth Form students are expected to dress in a manner appropriate to a purposeful, safe, secure and diverse learning environment. Students should always be mindful they are representing the school and our Sixth Form. Whilst we recognise that self-expression is part of being an emerging adult, items of dress that may reasonably be expected to cause offence to any member of the Sixth Form or wider community are not allowed to be worn. The following guidelines are set out to avoid offence or a breach of health and safety rules.

- No caps or hats, bandanas or hoods are to be worn on site.
- No ripped jeans or similar.
- No sportswear (eg. track suits, jogging bottoms) unless you are in a PE lesson.
- No clothing with offensive wording, logos, images or association.
- No clothes which expose an excessive amount of flesh and/or underwear including short denim shorts.
- Leggings or jeggings may be worn but need to be accompanied with a top, jumper or dress that completely covers the bottom.

<u>Student ID badges on lanyards</u> <u>must be worn at all times.</u>
